**RECIPE CORNER**

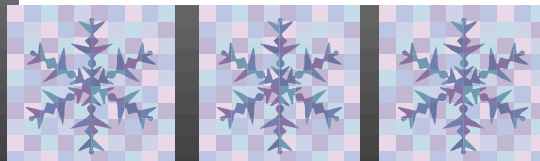
Reindeer Munchies

5 cups sweetened corn and oat honeycomb-shaped cereal  
2 cups thin pretzel sticks, broken in half  
1/2 cup butter  
1/2 cup creamy peanut butter  
1 11.5 ounce package milk chocolate chips  
1 cup powdered sugar  
1 cup red and green candy coated milk chocolate pieces

Combine cereal and pretzels in a large bowl and set aside.  
Place butter, peanut butter and chocolate chips in a medium microwave safe bowl. Microwave on high for 45 seconds; stir. Continue microwaving until butter and chocolate are melted. Stir until smooth.  
Immediately pour mixture over cereal in bowl. Stir until well coated. Spread mixture evenly into single layer on two waxed lined cookie sheets. Refrigerate 20 minutes.  
Break into bite size pieces and in a large bowl toss with powdered sugar to coat evenly. Add candy pieces and toss again. **ENJOY!**
